His mother is so upset, she throws the beans out the kitchen window. They grow overnight into the tallest beanstalk ever seen.

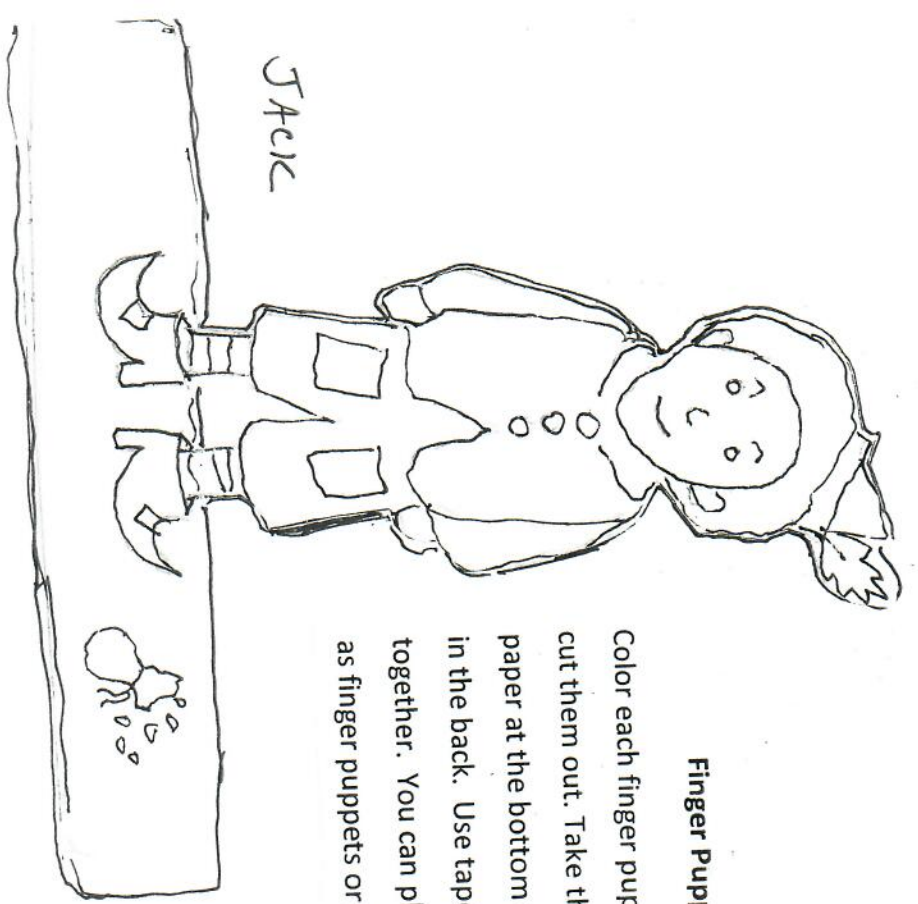

The goose who lays golden eggs and the magical singing harp

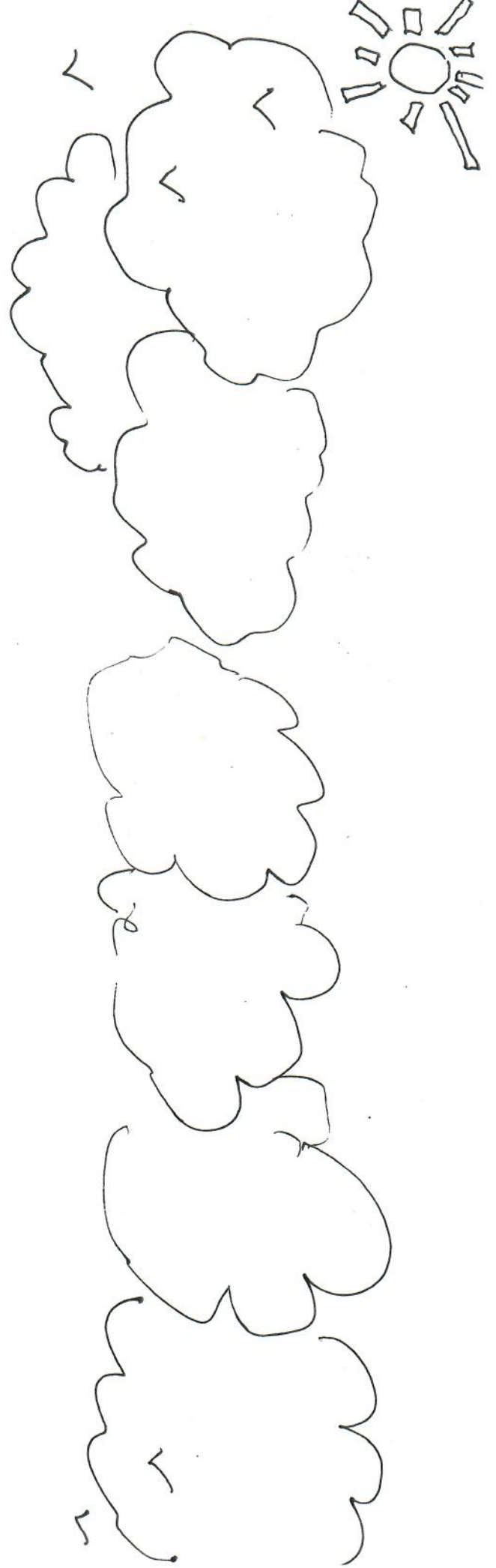
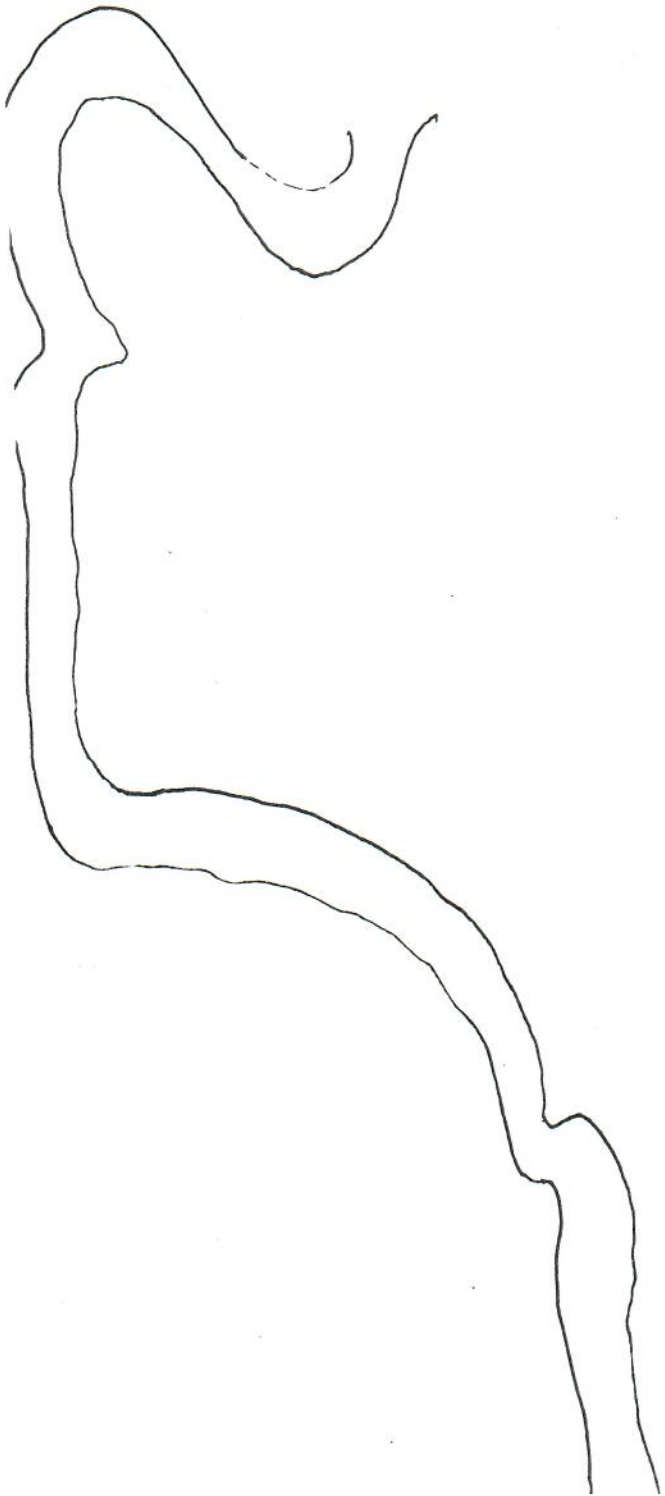


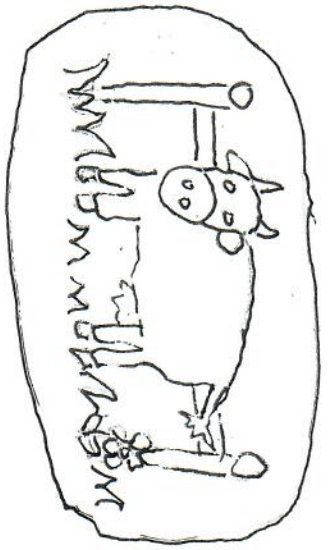
