

## **Museum Openings Update as of September 18th**

### **American Museum of Natural History**

Open to the public and our patrons September 9th. Timed ticketing required along with our vouchers. Please note that patrons should not click on any of the three boxes that appear on the museum reservation page. In the small print below the boxes there are instructions to “Click Here” to reserve timed tickets if you have vouchers. In the drawer with the vouchers there are copies of a screenshot (thanks to Chris) showing where patrons need to click to reserve timed tickets.

### **Boscobel House & Gardens**

Open with timed ticketing required along with our printable pass.

### **Bruce Museum**

Open with timed ticketing required along with our pass.

**Children’s Museum of the Arts** - Closed and won’t be opening until 2021

**Children’s Museum of Manhattan** - Closed

**Cooper Hewitt Design Museum** - Closed

### **El Museo Del Barrio**

Opens September 12th. Timed ticketing required. “Pay what you wish” policy.

### **Frick Collection**

Opens in January at its new temporary location (site of the former Met Breuer) while the permanent site is being renovated.

### **Guggenheim Museum**

Opens on October 3rd to the public. Members only September 30th to October 2nd. No details available.

### **Hudson River Museum**

Open with timed ticketing required along with our pass.

### **Intrepid Sea, Air and Space Museum**

Opens September 25th. Timed ticketing required along with our printable pass.

**Jewish Museum** - Opens October 1st for the general public and September 24th for members. Timed ticketing required along with our printable pass.

**Katonah Museum of Art**

Open with timed ticketing required along with our pass.

**Museum of the City of New York**

Open and patrons who borrow our pass are not now required to reserve a timed ticket but that is temporary.

**Museum of Modern Art**

Open and patrons who borrow our pass are not required to reserve a timed ticket! WOW!

**Neuberger Museum of Art - Closed****New York State Empire Pass**

Sites open with limited capacity. First come-first served.

**New York City Fire Museum**

Opens September 9th. Must call to book advance tickets and bring our pass.

**New York Historical Society**

Now a Printable Pass!

Opens to the public September 11th. Member preview day on September 10th. Timed ticketing required along with our printable pass. Patron must first reserve and print the library pass for the desired day. The printable pass includes the passcode: NEWROCHELLE2020. The patron must then go to the museum website and reserve their complimentary timed tickets by entering the passcode. Patron must bring both the printable pass and the timed ticket when visiting.

**New York Transit Museum - Closed****Paley Center for Media - Closed****Stamford Museum & Nature Center**

Open and does not require timed ticketing for any visitor.

**Stepping Stones Museum - Closed**

**Stone Barns** - There are no passes for Stone Barns this year.

**Storm King Art Center**

Open and requires timed ticketing along with our pass.

**Sugar Hill Museum of Art & Storytelling - Closed**

**Westchester County Children's Museum**

Closed for visiting but offering in-person Fall classes for children. Cannot use our pass for classes.

Please advise all patrons borrowing a pass to call or visit the museum website to learn about new requirements and revised days and hours of operation.

**Helpful Hint for patrons:** Go to the museum website to see if timed tickets are available for the day and time you wish to visit before you reserve the library pass.
